

2026 entry form and information

The Urunga Small Sculpture Prize is an award for original, freestanding or wall mounted sculpture of up to 50cm in any dimension.

The Urunga Small Sculpture Prize is hosted by the Urunga Art Space.

2026 prizes:

Conditions of entry

1. For the purpose of the Urunga Small Sculpture Prize, sculpture is defined as a freestanding, non-site-specific, three-dimensional object or a wall-mounted object. Wall-mounted work will, at a minimum, be required to demonstrate low relief and be fitted with a suitable hanging system.
2. Entries must not exceed 50cm in any dimension (height, width or depth) and must have a stable base. The overall weight must not exceed 20 kg and must allow for ease of mobility.
3. All entries must be the original work of the submitting artist and must have been designed or completed within two years prior to August 2026.
4. There is no limit to the number of entries an artist can submit. A separate application form and entry fee must accompany each entry. Only one work per artist may be shown in the exhibition.
5. A non-refundable entry fee of \$50 must accompany each entered work. Entry fees contribute towards the cost of staging the Prize.
6. Sculptures may be offered for sale. A sales commission of 30% will apply to all works sold.

Exhibition dates: 19th September – 17th October 2026
Pick up of unsold work: 18th October, 2026

Selection process

There will be two rounds of judging. The first round will be a pre-selection process by a qualified panel of four judges.

It is anticipated that approximately 45 sculptures will be selected for the exhibition by the pre-selection process.

Two further judges will decide the winners of the 2025 Urunga Small Sculpture Prize from the works selected for exhibition.

The 2025 Urunga Small Sculpture Prize winners will be announced at the opening of the exhibition on Sept. 19th

The People's Choice Award will be announced



following the conclusion of the exhibition.
